


Tuition-free STEM program for girls in grades 6 through 8.

Only 12% of engineers and 22% of computer professionals are women, and we want our girls to have the right tools to pursue all the opportunities available in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) fields.

Classes are held Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm during the summer (Campers will stay overnight at NIACC Dorms M - Th) and one Saturday a month throughout the school year.

- Meals will be provided over the summer.
- Participating students will receive a tablet for the duration of the program.
- Our program was developed in partnership with the National Association for Community College Entrepreneurship and Arizona State University and is expected to impact 1,500 girls across sixteen community college campuses.
