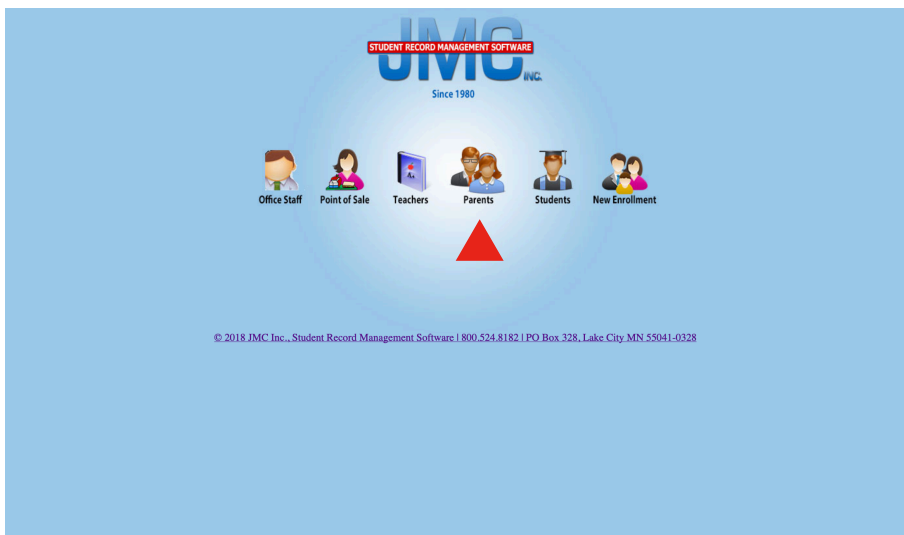


Note from NK: This program works best on a computer. If accessing from your phone, you will have to download the NK CSD App from your app store. Make sure you are in the correct school and the correct school year. IF you do not know your password, click forgot password link and it will direct you to enter the email on file at the school. The forgot password link will not always show up when accessing through your browser on your phone. When accessing lunch information, you may have to scroll to the bottom of your screen and click the Desktop link to make online payments show up.

Accessing the Parent Module

To begin, go to your district's jmc site. For example, <https://yourdistrict.onlinejmc.com>



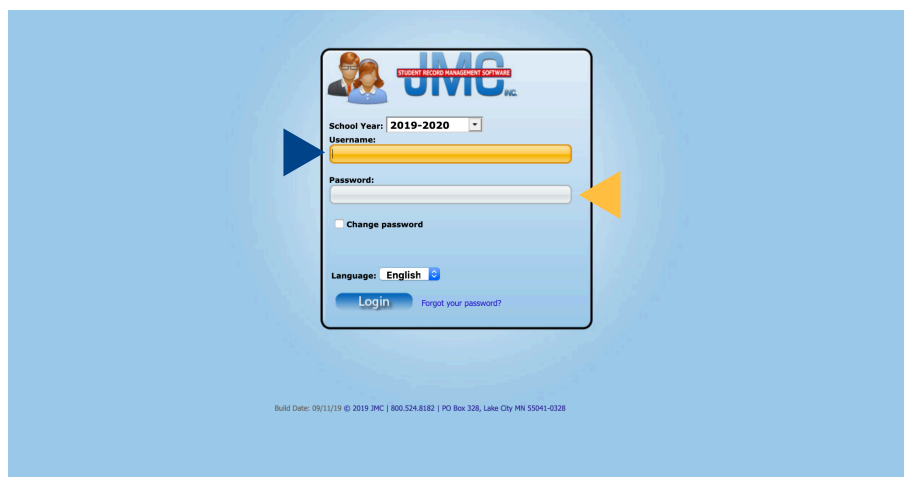
Step 1:

Helpful Tip: After visiting the Parent Module for the first time, you can bookmark the site for easy future access.



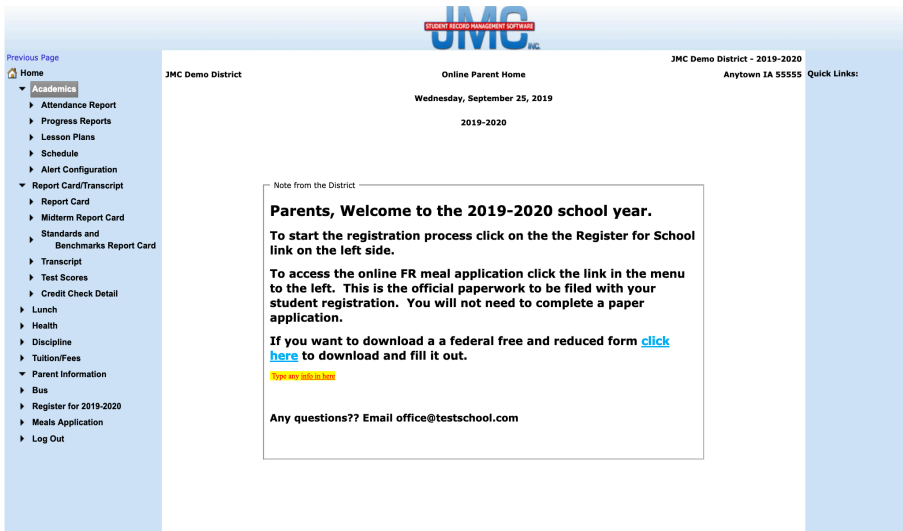
Step 1:

Helpful Tip: Make sure that you are logging into the correct school year!



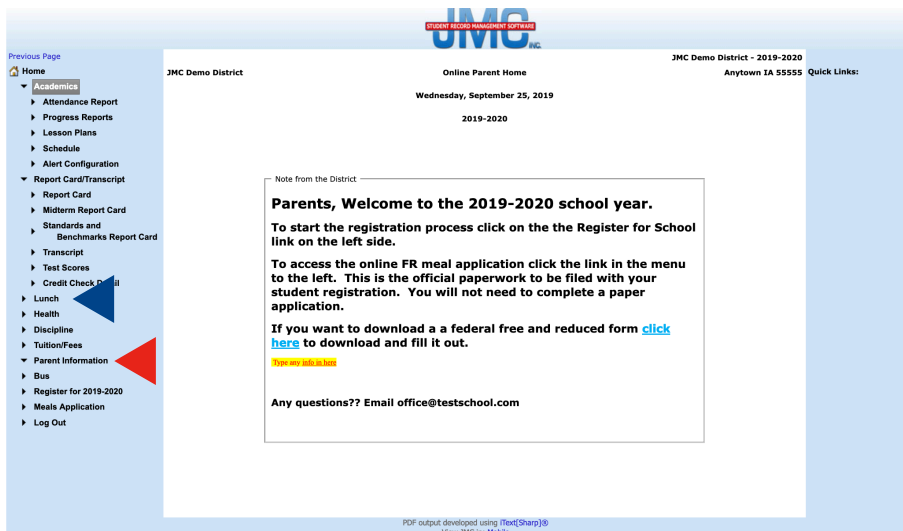
Note:

Helpful Tip: Not every option on the left is available at every school.



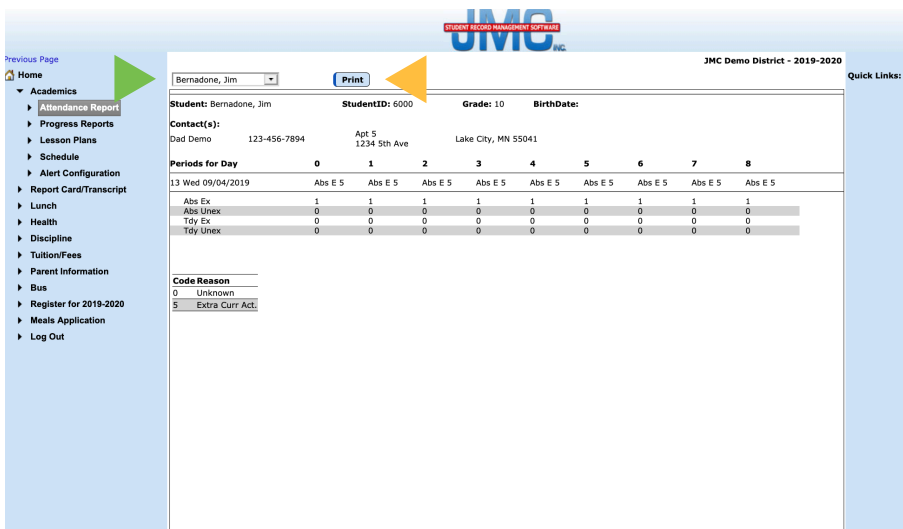
Step 1:
